SPEAKERS

GENERAL SESSIONS



Carlos Silva: Forest Mensuration. Carlos is an Assistant Professor of Quantitative Forest Science in the UF/IFAS School of Forest, Fisheries, & Geomatics Sciences (FFGS). He will discuss issues such as forest resource measurements, content estimation, forest inventory techniques, and stand growth and yield.



Tammy Cushing: Forest Taxation and Economics. Tammy is an Extension Forest Business Specialist at the University of Florida. She will help translate the tax system, especially the federal income tax code, and other economic considerations needed to make sound decisions in forest management.



Deborah Tannenbaum: Disaster Recovery Programs. Deborah is the director of the USDA-Farm Service Agency (FSA) in Florida. She will review the suite of disaster assistance programs offered by the agency to help producers prepare for and recover from the impacts of natural disasters and market volatility.



Juan Hernandez: Landowner Cost-Share Programs. Juan is the USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) State Conservationist in Florida. He will discuss technical and financial assistance available to landowners through the NRCS's Healthy Forests Reserve Program and the Agricultural Conservation Easement Program.



Marshall Thomas: Forestry Economic Update and Market Forecast. Marshall is president of F&W Forestry Services, Inc. Widely respected for his economic acumen, he is an Annual Meeting favorite. This year Marshall will again provide a forecast for the forest industry in the Southeast, with a special focus on Florida.
