NEW SALES TAX EXEMPTIONS APPROVED

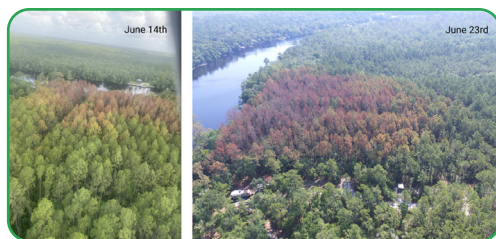


Thanks to the Florida legislature and everyone who worked together on this issue for multiple years, forestry and other ag groups will now benefit from two important sales tax exemptions: hog wire and barbed wire fencing (including gates and materials used to build or repair the fences) and trailers purchased exclusively for agricultural production, when purchased by the farmer or forestland owner.

These tax exemptions are tangible proof of your membership dollars at work.

SOUTHERN PINE BEETLE OUTBREAKS THREATEN FORESTS IN WAKULLA & FRANKLIN COUNTIES



This summer, the Florida Forest Service (FFS) has been responding to an outbreak of the Southern Pine Beetle within Franklin and Wakulla Counties.

FFS conducts aerial survey flights each year during peak season to detect Southern Pine Beetle activity and assist landowners with suppression efforts. So far this year, a record number of active outbreaks have been identified in Wakulla County.

FLORIDA FOREST SERVICE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR CARBON SEQUESTRATION PROGRAM



The Florida Forest Service is accepting applications for the 2022 Sequestering Carbon and Protecting Florida Land Program, a state-funded grant aimed at establishing and protecting robust forest lands in Florida by providing incentive payments to landowners.

"Forests are a critical component of addressing climate change, and 65 percent of Florida's forest lands are privately owned," said Commissioner Nikki Fried. "Supporting our forest landowners is vital to Florida's ecosystems and the timber industry. We must embrace natural climate solutions by keeping forests as forests, and the Sequestering Carbon and Protecting Florida Land Program does just that."

"The initial investment of site preparation, seedlings, and planting is costly," said Erin Albury, State Forester and Florida Forest Service Director. "The Sequestering Carbon and Protecting Florida Land Program helps landowners overcome the hurdle of establishment costs and works toward our mission of ensuring our state's forest lands are available for future generations."

FORESTRY FORWARD TOURS

This summer, the Forestry Forward Class 13 began their two-year leadership development programming with tours of the West Fraser Mill, Knight Farm and Andrews Nursery.



At the West Fraser Mill in Whitehouse, FL, the group learned all about the operations of the sawmill and planer mill. They were able to see the mills in action as well as witness

the behind the scenes processes that keep the mills productive. West Fraser is one of the largest lumber and oriented strand board manufacturers in the world.



Going a little wild on their next tour, the group visited Knight Farm, LLC, in Dixie County. The farm, owned and operated by Association member Dwight Knight, is known for its cutting-edge deer breeding and for its whitetail deer and exotics

hunting. Wildlife found on the property include whitetail deer, turkey, axis deer, antelope, elk, watusi, buffalo and more!

Dwight explained the art and science of deer breeding to the group, who were then taken on a tour of the property.

The Florida Forest Service (FFS) produces over eight million bare-root pine seedlings at Andrews Nursery. These seedlings are available for sale to non-industrial private landowners, corporate landowners and state and federal agencies to support Florida's reforestation needs.

Andrews Nursery also grows a combined total of over five million containerized pine seedlings and containerized wiregrass. For more than 55 years FFS has been committed to careful management of the nursery in order to provide top-quality seedlings for reforestation efforts in Florida.
